Introduction

Arrowhead Country Club is a family oriented private club located 15 miles north of Peoria just off Route 40. Arrowhead offers golf, swimming, fishing, camping and picnicking on over 200 acres of rolling countryside, lakes, and streams.

Members may join a variety of golf and swimming organizations along with enjoying a full calendar of social events. The two story, clubhouse overlooks the ninth green and the adjoining lakes providing a pastoral center for member activities.



Arrowhead Country Club has earned its reputation as a first rate recreational facility but yet affordable for most families.

Golf Organizations

Arrowhead's 18 hole, par 72 championship course has become the setting for some of Central Illinois' most enjoyable golf. This course features a variety of terrain and scenery making it challenging to golfers of all skill levels.



For the members who enjoy friendly competition, the Men, Women, and Junior Golf Associations stage tournaments and outings throughout the year. Their purpose is to properly encourage participation for members and to maintain the handicap system. They are also dedicated to upgrading and improving the course through fundraising activities. IVC High School and Dunlap High School both proudly claim Arrowhead as their home course for golf match competition.

Fishing & Camping

Arrowhead maintains two large lakes for fishing and boating with campsites and picnic facilities on shore. The lakes are stocked with game fish like Northern Pike, Bass, and Crappie as well as Bluegill and Catfish. A Children's Fishing Contest is held in the spring to introduce youngsters to fishing and many members take advantage of the campsites for outdoor family gatherings and overnight camping.



Swimming

Arrowhead installed three new pools in the spring of 2000, a four lane Olympic size lap pool, a twelve foot deep diving well and a shallow kiddy pool. The Pool Manager, under the direction of the Business Manager, is responsible for swim activities and swimming lessons at the Club including care and maintenance of the swimming pools and adjoining locker room areas for both men and women providing shower facilities and storage. The pool area is monitored by the manager and lifeguards. The pools are open for recreational swimming daily, weather permitting, June 1st thru August 31st.



Social Events

The social calendar at Arrowhead revolves around seasonal activities ranging from dinner dances and cocktail parties to informal outdoor events such as fish fry's and corn boils. Special activities for children include an Easter Egg Hunt, Kid's Fishing Derby, Family Fun Night and Breakfast with Santa.



Additional Information

Completed membership application requests will be considered by the board of directors at its regular monthly meetings. Arrowhead Country Club does not use race, creed, color, gender or age, religious beliefs or national origin as criteria for club membership. If at the time of membership approval the requested membership class is full, your name will be placed on a waiting list in the order it was approved.
