Notes from the Board Room

Dear fellow Members,

HAPPY GOLF SEASON!! With a very mild winter and what appears to be an early spring, the golf course was opened the earliest I can remember in several years. Over the past couple of months, the Board, committees and managers have been hard at work to get ready for the upcoming year. Below is an update on several items including membership levels, membership promotions, POS system update, dues payment policy, cart lease update and golf course improvements.

As of the Board meeting on Wednesday, March 14, membership was at 368, which includes 41 new members, 15 drops and 1 transfer to social since the January Board meeting. This brings the total new members that have joined Arrowhead since last October to 48 and the total drops to 27. **Welcome new members to Arrowhead Country Club!!!!** At the March Board meeting last year, membership was at 328. The combination of the new dues structure, bunker renovation project, well maintained golf course, membership promotions and a great job by our managers in marketing and promoting the Club during the off season has contributed to this large increase in membership. Since the March Board meeting, we have received several additional membership applications and plan to continue marketing the spring promotions heavily in the next couple of months to continue bringing in additional new members to the Club.

The current membership promotion, which expires March 31st, includes a free single cart plan (\$375 value) and a reduced initiation fee only if multiple members join together. The next membership promotion, which runs from April 1st through May 31st, includes a \$200 food/beverage credit, a chance to get 50% off of dues for 2013 and a reduced initiation fee only if multiple members join together. Additionally, any existing member that recruits a new member through May 30th will have their name put into a drawing to win a trip to Las Vegas for 3 days and 2 nights (airfare and lodging).

As mentioned in the last newsletter, we have selected Club Prophet Systems to provide our planned POS system at the Club. The current plan is for the system to be installed in mid April. The system will provide an improved membership experience and will help in the management of the Club. See the separate communication from Cam Brewer included in the newsletter for additional information.

The membership committee has been reviewing the Club's payment policy as it relates to dues payments and food/beverage in-house charges. To provide a clear definition of the options for members to pay their dues and how penalties/suspensions for non-payment or late payment of dues are handled at the beginning of the year, the committee developed an updated policy that was presented to and accepted by the Board at the March Board meeting. See the updated policy included separately in the newsletter. The committee will continue to review the current policy related to monthly dues payments and food/beverage charges and will be discussing this with the Board at the April meeting.

During the off season, Doug Pinter spearheaded an effort to assess our golf cart options for the end of 2012 when our current golf cart lease expires. Several options have been considered including gas and electric carts as well as multiple brands including Club Car and Yamaha. Based on all the analysis, which included annual lease cost, up front investment (related to electric carts), space requirements (related to electric carts), manpower requirements, reliability and fuel consumption, a recommendation was presented to and accepted by the Board at the March Board meeting to enter into an agreement with Yamaha gas carts at the end of our current lease. By making the decision now, we have the opportunity to lock in at the current lease rate before rates increase for 2013. The annual lease cost will be slightly higher than our current lease, which was based on a used fleet of carts. The increase in annual lease cost will be offset partially by a 30% improvement in fuel economy of the new carts. The

plan is for the new fleet of carts to arrive in mid-September 2012 and be ready for use when the current lease expires at the end of September 2012.

The Grounds and Greens Committee along with Reid Koberg, our Golf Course Superintendent, has been assessing the priorities for the golf course and looking at ways to improve playability for the coming year. Some initial improvements already made include the removal/trimming of some trees on the left side of #11 fairway, the removal of the large tree on the right side of #16 fairway and the removal of trees short and left of #4 green near the fence. Additional plans for the year include replacing the cart paths on #5 and #17, as well as rebuilding the ladies tee box on #17. The committee will continue to discuss other improvements for the golf course for this year and will continue to develop a longer term plan for improvements as well.

I am looking forward to another great season at Arrowhead Country Club. Hope to see everyone at the Club soon.

McNaught called meeting to order. Firebaugh motion to approve February meeting minutes. Jenkins 2nd. All approved.

Guests: None

Manager Reports:

Reid Koberg: Indicated he had just mowed the greens for the first time. He is pleased with how they are looking this early in the season. Tees will be mowed this week, followed by the fairways. He is looking to get a stump grinder for removal of some of the larger stumps. Tolly shared with him a concern from a member on the process of opening of the course. Reid is the sole decision maker on this process. He does not wait or speed up the decision based on input from the Board.

Doug Pinter: Reminded Board and Membership they can call 274-4675 ext. 110 for course conditions and playability. He has hired Jared Johnson as his first assistant. Greg Anderson, former manager of Golf Discount, will be his Pro Shop Manager. ¾ of cart fleet is gassed and power washed. He had a Yamaha golf cart to show the Board. Presented lease proposals for both Club Car and Yamaha to replace our current fleet at the end of 2012. It was suggested to Doug he look into implementing a "Military Day" at ACC. An idea that would encourage membership to wear a certain color one day of the week to honor our military. He will look into this idea.

Cam Brewer: 368 membership. 17 new memberships to approve tonight. 1 Regular, 4 intermediate, 9 Junior, 1 Single and 2 Senior. 7 drops (4 Reg. 1 Inter. and 2 to inactive). 328 memberships as of this time last year. He is continuing some advertising with the Journal Star. will be on radio show with Jim Saur to promote ACC. He is looking into updating or developing a new easier to navigate ACC website. 30 ACC picture books are still available and can be purchased in the Clubhouse. Switching from Waugh to Kohl for food service and will be looking at providing some healthier menu options. POS system should be up and running by April 18th. All equipment is in and installation/training is scheduled for April 15-17.

Committee Reports:

Finance: McNaught reported for Oertley. Reported on some balance sheet and income statement adjustments. Year to date net income is about \$41,000 favorable to the business plan. Year to date income is \$73,000 favorable to the plan primarily due to the timing of dues income and expenses are \$32,000 unfavorable to the plan primarily due to the timing of member incentives and fertilizer purchases.

Grounds and Greens: No report.

Golf: No report.

Other Facilities: Jenkins reported no issues currently. No big Facility plans scheduled for 2012.

Pool: Buysee indicated Aleah is working on staffing for this Summer.

Long Range Planning: McNaught presented Board with update on Strategic Objectives.

Personnel: McNaught reported Managers have been working on updating Employee manuals.

Member Relations: McNaught reported in Norbom's absence. Committee has looked into policy concerning on time payment of dues. Cam and Aleah are updating membership book.

I would like to remind everyone that we require carts to stay on cart paths at all times on par 3's and to keep carts 50 yards from the green, when not on cart paths. Also, please make sure you are fixing your balls, I have noticed several marks on the green that are now dead spots, as people are not fixing marks when they are made.

Tee Times. First day to make tee times is on April 1st, for April 1st and 7 days out. We take tee times 7 days in advance, 15 minutes prior to the first tee time of that day. You may make two tee times per membership, per day. We are hoping to have tee times go online sometime early May. I will have more information on this in my next newsletter.

Friendly reminder, all members receive member pricing in the pro shop. I knock 10% of the suggested retail price, as my way of saying "thank you" for supporting the pro shop. I offer custom fitting of clubs (Drivers, fairways, hybrids, irons, wedges as well as PUTTERS). I have a Launch Monitor and a state of the art Putter fitting system. I am currently receiving inventory on a daily basis. If you are interested in trying a new club on the market, or a belly putter, just stop in the shop and we will get you setup. I am also keeping busy on the lesson tee as golfers are trying to knock off the rust from the winter months. If I can help you with your game please let me know. 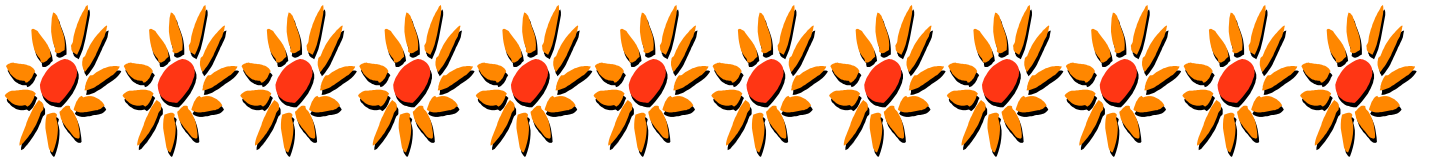

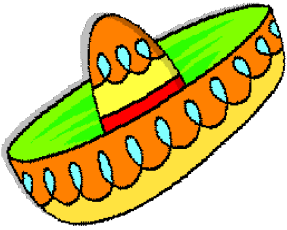

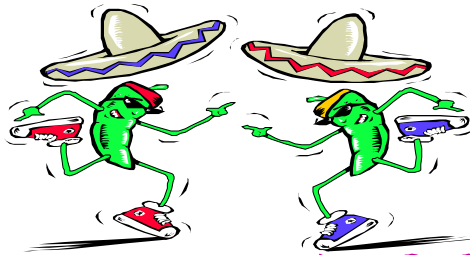

You are cordially invited to participate in the **2012 Arrowhead Men's Invitational**. Listed below are the details of this exciting competition:

Calendar of events: Thursday July 5, Friday July 6 and Saturday July 7, 2012.

- Thursday, July 5: Practice round- tee times from 12:00 to 2P.M.
- Friday, July 6: Day one of competition. 12:30 P.M. shotgun.
- Saturday, July 7: Day two of competition.1 P.M. shotgun with Championship playoff and awards ceremony.

Format:

- Two person teams consisting of one Arrowhead Member and one guest.
- Each two man team will be flighted by combined handicap.
- There will be six teams per flight with a minimum of five flights (30 teams) and a maximum of eight flights (48 teams).
- Within each flight, each two man team will play every other team within the flight in a series of five nine hole matches.
- Scoring of each nine hole match will be a net team best ball match play format. A total of nine points will be available in each match. One point will be awarded if a team wins a hole and one half point to each team if the hole is halved.

- At the conclusion of the five nine hole matches the team with the most points in each flight will be declared the flight winner. In the event of ties, the flight winner will be determined by scorecard playoff.
- The flight winners will participate in a Championship playoff to determine the 2012 overall Arrowhead Invitational Champion.
- The Championship playoff format will consist of the flight winning teams playing an alternate shot net team best ball competition until all but one flight winner is eliminated.

CLUB DUES AND PAYMENT POLICY

This policy is designed to provide a clear definition of the options for members to pay their dues and how penalties/suspensions for non-payment or late payment of dues are handled. Members must understand that being a member of a private club comes with certain responsibilities regarding their payments. It is time consuming for the staff of Arrowhead Country Club to monitor and address late payments and this time could be spent on more productive activities in support of the Club. Additionally, it is not fair to members in good standing who pay their bills in a timely manner, to be expected to tolerate those members who do not pay timely. The following is the Club policy and procedures regarding members' dues payments.

1. Dues statements will be sent out for the next year by Nov 1st. Members have the option to pay dues by 3 different methods:
 - A. 12 monthly installments (15th of each month November through October)
 - B. 3 installments (January 15th, March 15th, May 15th)
 - C. Pay in full (by November 30th - 2% discount on dues and cart plan, by December 31st - 1% discount on dues and cart plan or by Jan 15th with no discount).
2. Regardless of payment method selected, dues are deemed late after January 15th if no payment is made. Monthly plan installments are figured by the total dues divided by the remaining months through October and the 1st monthly installment is due immediately. Under the 3 installments plan, the first installment is due immediately and the pay in full option the entire amount is due in full. A 30 day grace period will be in effect (through February 15th), at which time a late fee charge of \$25 will be assessed to the account. Additionally, every 30 days thereafter until the late dues situation is resolved, another \$25 late fee will be assessed.
3. All Club privileges will be suspended as of March 15th if there have been no payments received, or there has been no contact by the member to Club office to arrange for a resolution. Payments including late fees must be brought up to date before suspension of privileges are lifted. Hardship cases will be taken on an individual basis by the Club Manager and the Membership Committee.
4. If no payment or contact to the Club office has occurred to arrange for a resolution by May 1ST, the member will be terminated as an active member of the Club. To reactivate the membership with the Club, the member must submit a new member application, which must be approved by the Board of Directors. Additionally, all late fees previously assessed and the current initiation fee must be paid. A terminated member resulting from a lack of dues payments is not eligible for any new membership promotions in effect at the time of their application to become an active member of the Club again.
